Día de los Muertos Lesson Plans

Week 1: Introduction to Día de los Muertos

Day 1: Monday, October 26, 2026

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the basic concept of Día de los Muertos
- Identify the dates of the celebration
- Recognize the purpose of the holiday

Lesson Plan:

1. Introduction (5 minutes)
 - Greet students and introduce the topic of Día de los Muertos
2. KWL Chart (10 minutes)
 - Have students fill out a KWL chart (Know, Want to know, Learned)
 - Discuss what they already know about Día de los Muertos
3. Presentation (15 minutes)
 - Show slides 1-3 from the presentation
 - Explain the basic concept and dates of Día de los Muertos
4. Discussion (5 minutes)
 - Ask students to share ways they remember special people in their lives
5. Closure (5 minutes)
 - Recap key points
 - Preview next lesson

Homework:

Ask students to bring a photo of a deceased loved one or a famous person they admire for the next class.

Tips for Teachers:

- Be sensitive to students who may have recently experienced loss
- Emphasize that Día de los Muertos is a celebration of life, not a sad occasion

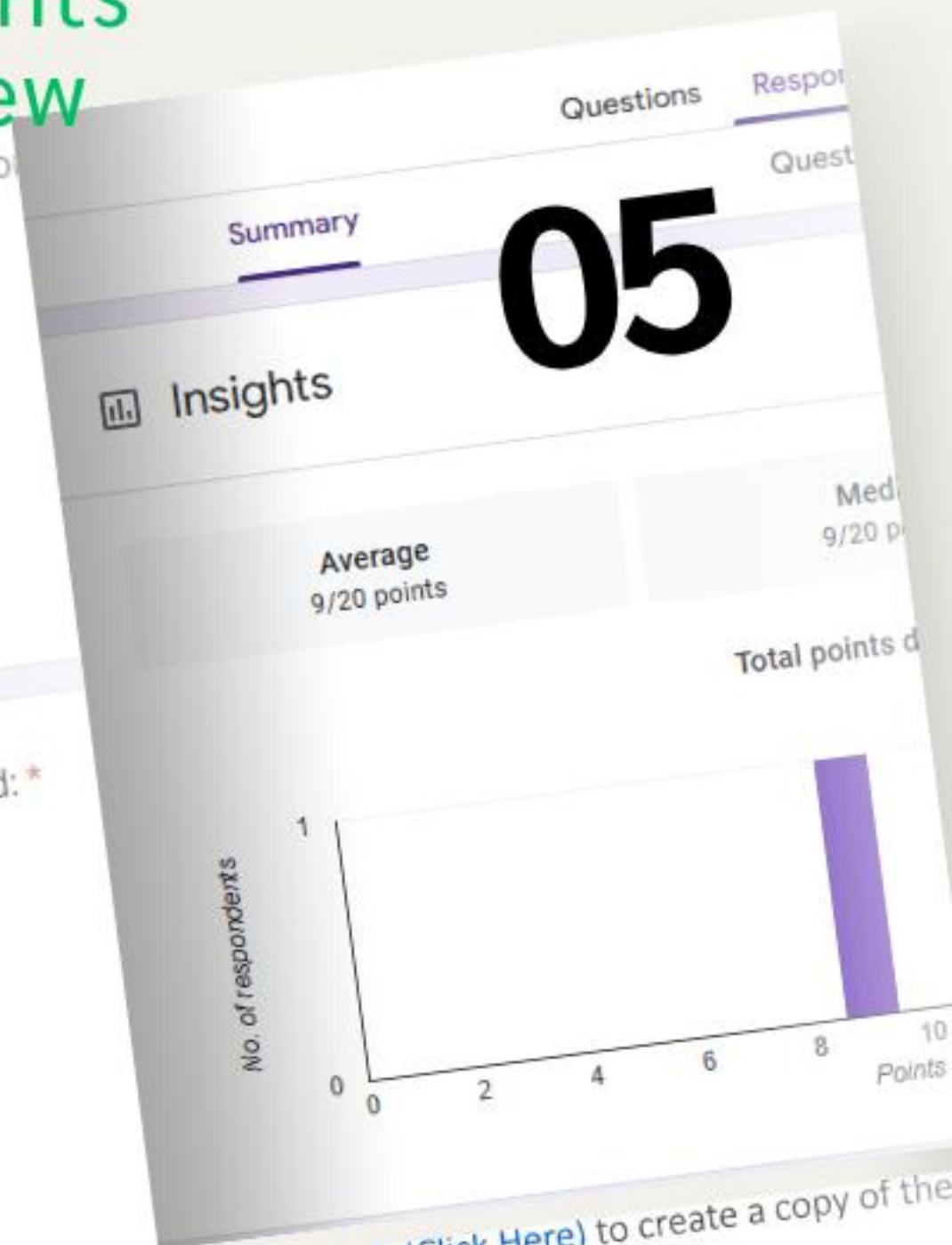

Answer Key

Sample Answer to Question 1

A declarative sentence states a fact or opinion and ends with a period.
Example: "The sky is blue."

Sample Answer to Question 2

To turn a declarative sentence into an interrogative sentence, add a question word or auxiliary verb and end with a question mark.
Example: "The sky is blue." becomes "Is the sky blue?"

Sample Answer to Question 3

The main purpose of an exclamatory sentence is to express strong emotion or excitement.

Sample Answer to Question 4

Common question words: Who, What, Where (also How, When, Why)

Sample Answer to Question 5

A period at the end of an imperative sentence gives it a command. An exclamation point adds urgency or emphasis.
